PURPOSE OF REPORT: To recommend financial assistance under the Athletes Assistance Policy.

KEY ISSUES

Athletes Assistance for Piper Duck

INTRODUCTION

On the 14th of November 2016 Council received correspondence from Michelle Duck (refer attached) requesting financial assistance for her daughter Piper's sporting endeavours, specifically representing ACT Brumbies 7's and NSW Country in basketball.

BACKGROUND

Council's Athletes Assistance Policy states that:

Local athletes who make appropriate application and who are a resident of Tumut Shire selected to represent at a State, National or International level in any officially organised sporting fixture, with the stipulation that the maximum amount to be allocated to each individual player or competitor be \$100.00 and that the maximum payable to any team be \$300.00.

COMMENTS

Given the application is in accordance with the Athletes Assistance Policy it is recommended Council allocated the appropriate funding.

RECOMMENDATION

That Council provide \$100 from the Athletes Assistance fund to Piper Duck for representing the ACT Brumbies 7's and the NSW Country team in the Under 18 Australian Country Junior Basketball Cup.

I am hoping that your committee may be able to provide some financial support to Piper Duck whom is a young athlete and has just been selected for the following two major sporting events:

U/17 ACT Brumbies 7's Team to compete at the 7's Nationals in Perth on the 10th and 11th December 2016.

U/18 NSW Country Team to compete at the 2017 Australian Country Junior Basketball Cup in Albury on the 14th to the 21st January 2017.

Piper has also been selected for the following programs and competitions:

NSW Basketball D-League (Top 40 U/18 NSW Metro and Country Players) competing in Sydney for four weekends.

NSW Basketball State Performance Program (one of 31 players to receive the program) requires attendance at camps in Sydney and a weekly training program.


The four selections above incur selection fees totaling \$2,530. This does not include the cost of accommodation, travel, training and weekend camps.

Piper has been travelling to Sydney every weekend since 1st October 2016 to attend NSW Basketball commitments, whilst attending training in Canberra on Friday afternoons before heading to Sydney and Sunday afternoons on her way home from Sydney with the ACT Brumbies.

Piper will be involved with NSW Basketball (Terrigal/Newcastle) and ACT Brumbies (Canberra/Perth) commitments every weekend to Christmas.
