TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF USE

- The trap is provided to users on the basis that a deposit is paid, which is refunded upon the return of the trap. The customer shall accept full responsibility for loss or damage to the trap. The traps are valued at approx. \$125.00 (Cat) - \$650.00 (dog) each and by signing the document; the user acknowledges responsibility for any loss or damage to the trap.
- 2. The maximum period of trap availability to any one resident is a 14 day period, which includes weekends. Council has only a limited number of traps available and they are in high demand.
- 3. Cats may be deposited at the Council Cat Pound drop boxes at 50 Gocup Road, or you may contact the Ranger on duty during regular business hours - Monday to Friday 08:30 am to 4.30 pm.
- 4. Tumbarumba does not have a Cat pound Drop box.
- 5. Council officers do not collect cats on weekends or after hours. It is best not to set the trap Friday nights through Sunday Morning unless you are comfortable putting it in the Tumut drop box.
- 6. Cat traps will not only be issued for possums. If you have a possum problem, you must contact National Parks and Wildlife Services. In the event this trap does catch a possums, the possum must be released in the location where it is caught.
- 7. Cat traps may only be set up and used on your own property. They may not be used on public lands.
