THE ROSEWOOD BUSHFIRE BRIGADE SHED WAS BUILT BY THE ROSEWOOD BUSH FIRE BRIGADE ON THE PROPERTY OF THE ROSEWOOD GOLF IN ABOUT 1970, AS A PERMANENT BUILDING TO HOUSE THE ROSEWOOD BUSH FIRE BRIGADE TANKER AND EQUIPMENT. IT WAS NECESSARY AND BADLY NEEDED BY THE DISTRICT.

THE SHED WAS ERECTED BY BRIGADE MEMBER OWEN PORTORS, WHO HAD A STEEL FABRICATION AND BUILDING BUSINESS IN ROSEWOOD WITH THE HELP OF LOCALS WORKING ON THE PROJECT.

ALL THE MATERIALS USED, STEEL, IRON, BOLTS, TIMBER, ROOFING NAILS USED IN BUILDING THE SHED WERE DONATED BY THE ROSEWOOD COMMUNITY. ALL LABOUR SUPPLIED WAS ALSO GIVEN FREELY, SPONTANEOUSLY & JOYFULLY, NO INDIVIDUAL WAS PAID FOR THEIR CONTRIBUTION TO THIS PROJECT. OWEN PORTOR'S STILL RESIDES IN THE ROSEWOOD VILLAGE AND HE CAN WILL TESTIFY TO THE ABOVE STATEMENTS.
