- 4. <u>Ciderfest Special Event Application</u> Committee reviewed, noted it to be compliant and approved the application.
- 5. Road Safety Officer position Committee advised that the position will be re-advertised.
- 6. <u>Simpson Street extension of bus zone for Tumut Public School</u> Glen McGrath followed up, action completed, and extension is now in place.
- East Gilmore Road and Batlow Road (MR4) Intersection Paul Matheson to follow up with Greg Minehan.
- 8. <u>The Glen Estate Tumut traffic</u> ongoing.
- 9. <u>Location markers on Snowy Mountains Highway up Talbingo Mountain</u>. Location markers being installed along with appropriate signage ongoing.
