TENDER AWARDED FOR BRINDABELLA ROAD SURVEY AND DESIGN

Council has appointed Rigore Engineering Services to undertake road survey and design of the 10.6km section of the Brindabella road from the intersection of Goodradigbee River Bridge to the NSW/ACT State border, as a sealed road,

Mayor Julia Ham said "Major upgrades and sealing of Brindabella Road have long been an advocacy priority of Council and we have been supported in this vision with over \$37 million in federal government funding thanks to support by the Hon Kristy McBain MP."

Significant upgrades to Brindabella Road are a step closer with Stage 1, the survey and design work estimated to get underway in early 2025.

It is estimated that road construction will commence in late 2025.
