8.8. WEIGHT LIMIT REVIEW - LITTLE RIVER ROAD GOOBARRAGANDRA**RECOMMENDATION:****THAT COUNCIL:**

1. **Install a traffic counter on the Little River Road Goobarragandra to record heavy vehicle movements, if the movements are above average, then an additional report be provided to the Local Traffic Committee.**

9. GENERAL BUSINESS:

- Snowy Mountains Highway - Trees on either side of the road are dead & have been dropping limbs - in the vicinity of "Rock Lodge" and the 50km/hr speed zone going in to Adelong. Council to write to Transport for NSW raising issue with them.
- Residence in Lockhart Street, Adelong - issue with caravan and unregistered vehicles on naturestrip outside property. Issue to be raised with Council's Ranger to follow up.

- Residents on the Grahamstown side of Adelong - increase in heavy vehicles travelling this particular section of road. Will be flagged for Council to put a traffic counter on this section of road.
- Speed limits at Brungle - approval has been granted by Transport for NSW. Signs have been ordered and will be put up within the next few weeks.
- It is expected that Council will receive the Special Event Application for the upcoming Hume and Hovell Ultra Marathon. It is expected that there will be changes to this Event from previous years.
- Council has received an inquiry from a Rosewood resident with regards to starting up "horse and cart" rides on roads. To be followed up with Transport for NSW.
