4.2 Youth Committee T Shirts

It is proposed that the Youth Council Committee get matching t-shirts and redesign a new logo. The committee discussed options and thought that having shirts that easily identify Youth Council members, and feature colours similar to Snowy Valleys Council branding colours, with highlights of bright pink. The Youth Council members will send through ideas to the Community Development Officer. The Community Development Officer will also reach out to the Tumut Art Gallery for suggestions to create the logo design.

4.3 Events & Grants Officer

The Events & Grants Officer joined the meeting to present the upcoming calendar of events for the school holiday period and to obtain feedback on future plans and needs guided by the Youth Council Committee.

There was also a discussion held about the "Youth Opportunities Fund" and if the Committee would like to apply, however the activities must be led and delivered by Youth. The Events & Grants Officer will share information about this to the Committee. Applications close on the 15 July 2024.

Some ideas for the funding opportunity were discussed, including having a Creative Art Wall in each town, to hold a Youth Music Festival or a Youth Forum - these would need to also be considered against the guidelines for the grant fund.

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Winter School Holidays

Council will be delivering a series of skills-based programs during the Winter School Holidays which has been funded by the School Holidays Break Program. These courses will be free for youth aged 14-24 to complete:

- Hair and Makeup Workshops in Tumbarumba and Tumut
- White Card Training in Tumut
- First Aid Training in Tumbarumba and Tumut

Spring School Holidays

Ideas suggested for the Spring and Summer School Holidays were:

- A Colour Run
- Foam Run (different version of the colour run)
- Team buildings activities

Summer School Holiday

- Water run and water-based activities
- Pool Parties (pending grant funding)

4.4 Road Safety Officer

The Youth Committee members raised concerns about the Main street in Tumbarumba and suggested reducing the vehicle speed. The Road Safety Officer suggested that a radar can be fitted to record information about how fast people are travelling. This information will then be used in partnership with the NSW Police to improve road user outcomes.

It was also noted that the Old Tumbarumba Road will have signage installed to enforce the tonnage limit.
