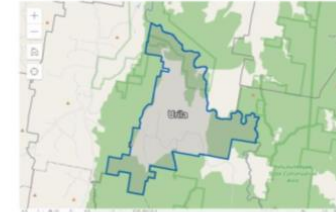
## Program Background

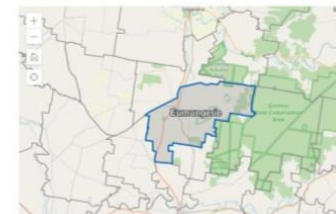

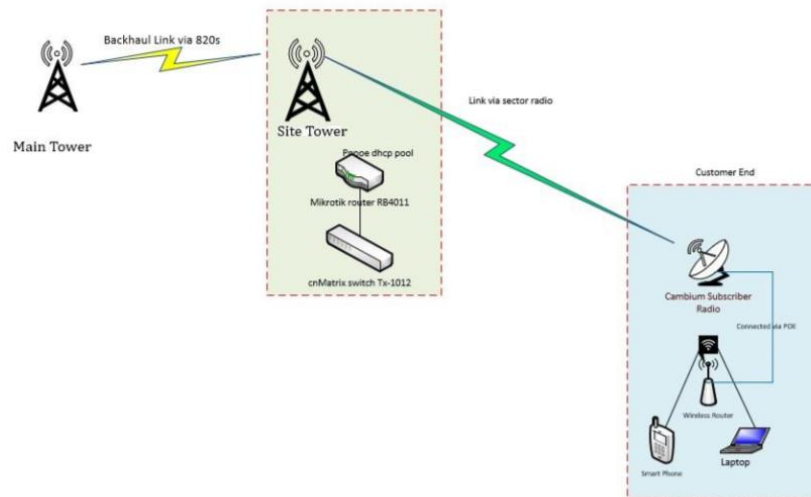
