7. BUSINESS ARISING:

- Electronic Message Board (sign) on the Snowy Mountains Highway - display message never changes. Councillor Thomson has contacted Joe McGirr's office in relation to this, along with Transport for NSW. Sign is controlled by the Transport Management Centre.
- Disability Parking Spaces that was raised at the previous meeting. Item was raised again mentioning that problem is more than just educating people on requirements/ time limits? There

are quite a few medical facilities in and around the Tumut CBD and little/ no defined disability parking. Disability Parking was undertaken at part of the Tumut Traffic Study, this was undertaken approximately 4 years ago. Needs to be a review undertaken of parking in and around Russell Street in Tumut.

- Tumut Valley Holiday Park - request for additional signage. Request has been forwarded to Transport fNSW Signage and Delineation Manager. Request has been rejected. Advice has been received that if Holiday Park wants additional advertising signage then they are required to submit a Development Application to Council for consideration.
